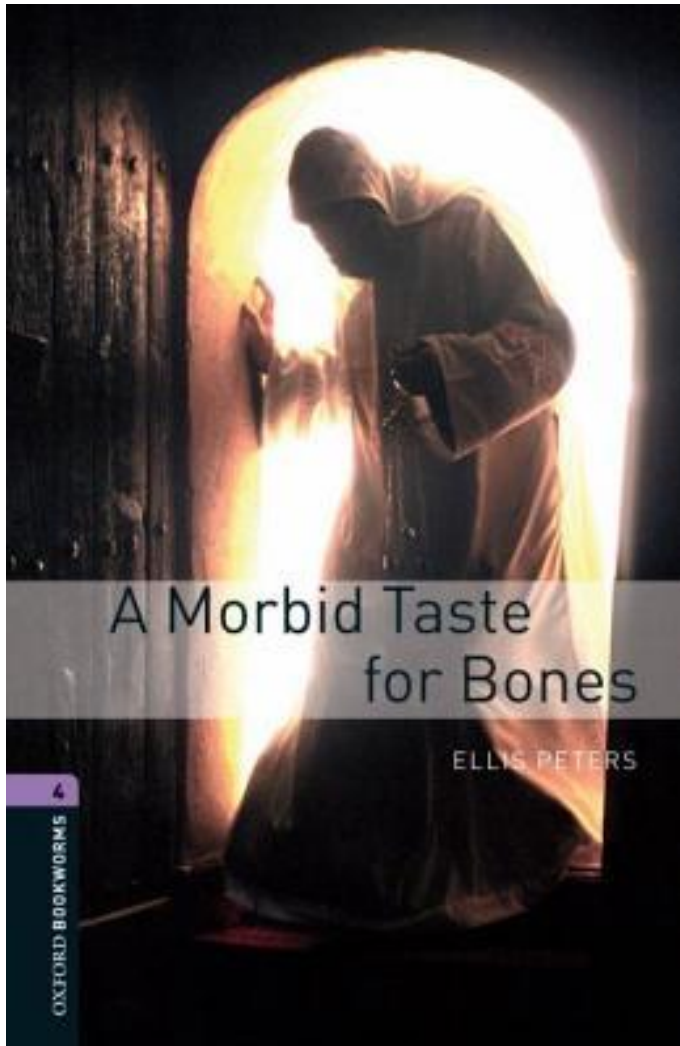

PEI Public Library Service: When one of our libraries decided to try a medieval mystery book club, the Chronicles of Brother Cadfael by Ellis Peters was the first series selected. Readers could choose to read any one of the twenty books in the series, but -- after reading one book -- most readers went on to read multiple books in the series. Some of the people planning on attending the book club were long-time fans who owned the entire series of books and had watched the DVDs. Brother Cadfael is the mystery-solving Benedictine monk at the center of each of the novels. The historical setting and time period appears as another character in the series. Among other things, readers learn about methods of travel, farming, clothing, and the inner workings of a Benedictine abbey. They also get an entertaining education about the evolution of the struggle between King Stephen and Empress Maud for control of the throne. After spending decades as a soldier and sailor, Cadfael came later to the monastic life, which means he has worldly skills and attitudes that are not normally found within the confines of a medieval monastery. These skills put him in unique and interesting situations. Even after reading a single book in the series, the reader feels that Cadfael is a fully-developed person. In each book, readers learn more details about Cadfael: his past, his relationships, and his attitudes. Like Louise Penny's Chief Inspector Armand Gamache series, the evolution of the characters in the Brother Cadfael books has the same appeal. Cadfael books are a cozy and delightful read.

Willow : This book is actually quite good.

I must admit though, I had a hard time getting through it. In fact, I pretty much had to sit myself down and force myself to read through to the end. I've decided that has much more to do with me than the book itself (consequently my high rating). The truth is, I just don't like mysteries, and now I know that even by setting the mystery in a fascinating time period, this doesn't change. When I was younger, I used to read every Agatha Christi 'Poirot' story I could get my hands on, and I think I burned myself out. Most of the time I just don't care about 'whodunit'. This leaves the magnetism of the detective to carry the story, which recently just hasn't been enough.

For people who love mysteries though, I think you will love this. Peters writes very well. She uses dialogue to bring her characters to life, and it's great. I was surprised at how funny this book was. Cadfael is simply a GREAT character. Peters also captures the 1100s with insightful details into monasterial life. I think so many authors forget how powerful and important the church truly was during this time. This same attention to detail was used on the inner workings of a medieval Welsh village too. So many books just make out the villagers out to be ignorant clods, but Ellis is much more generous than that, giving everybody a more rounded feel. Everybody has a different agenda and a different motive, and Cadfael is able to work this out quite clearly and succinctly.

Maybe someday I will be in the mood to read another Cadfael book, but I think I'm going to skip historical mysteries for a while. I do believe this is the *crème de la crème* of historical mysteries though.

Gillian Kevern: Shame on me for not reading this sooner! Thoroughly enjoyed this, my first Brother Cadfael mystery.

Nathan: Enjoyable background candy. I locate myself taking up the speech mannerisms of the books I am reading, and after approximately a dozen Brother Cadfael's I used to be a jogging speaking 12C monk. The mysteries are rather gentle, regardless of that includes murders. Brother Cadfael, the protagonist, isn't installed danger--compare, for example, to Dick Francis the place nearly each publication gains the hero getting crushed up two times (once to teach that he feels pain, and back to teach that he is courageous sufficient to take the thrashing he is aware is coming).
