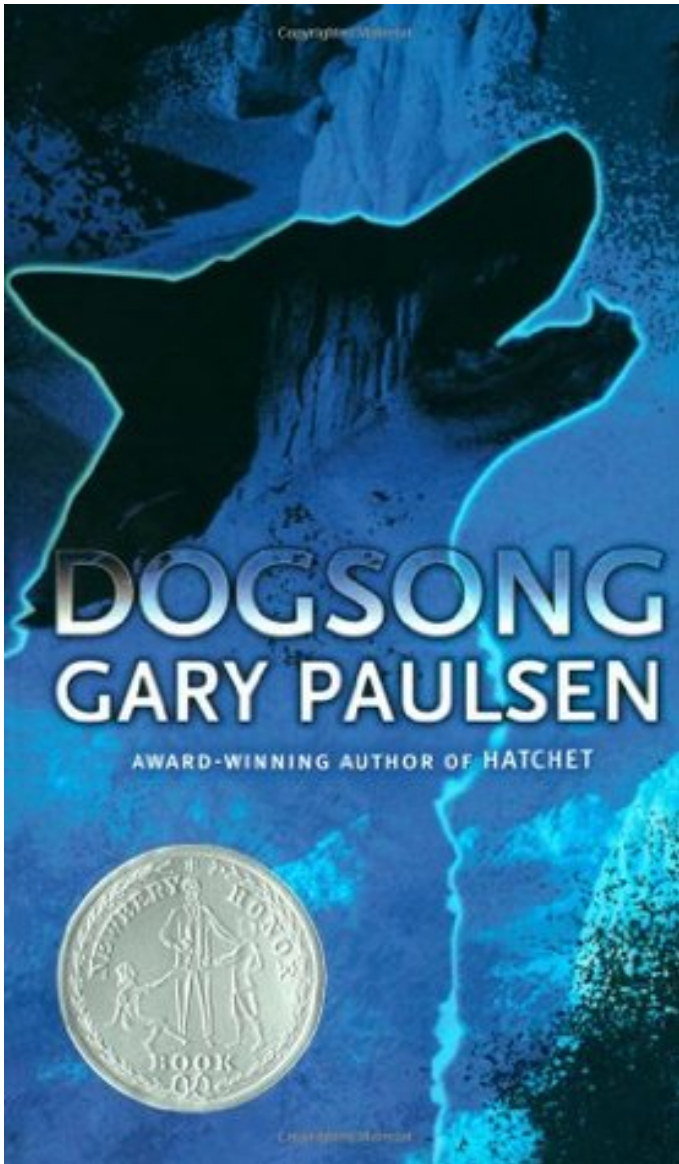

Scott Gill: A much needed book for boys today. It is rough and raw, a survival story which is so characteristic of Paulsen. A coming-of-age story, but more than that; it is the story of a boy that makes the passage to manhood. Russel Susskit begins as an eskimo boy, living with his sick father on the government reservation and ends as a man, living on his own, surviving by the "old ways." His passage involves the hunt, running dogs, and a journey where he finally finds his song, his meaning and place in the world.

Riley: The title of this book is *Dogsong*. The author is Gary Paulson. *Dogsong* has 176 pages and the genre is biography. In this book the main character is Russel. He lives with his dad at the beginning of the book but he doesn't know what to do with his life so he goes to a man named Oogruk's house. This man Oogruk was the founder of the village Russel lives in. Oogruk starts to give Russel a lot of advice so Russel moved into his house to get more advice.
