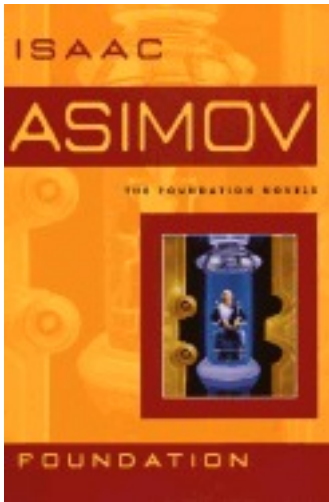

Katie: A book that's more intriguing than good, I think. I get why it's a classic - the book is full of interesting ideas, and Asimov does a fun job in taking the large scale forces of earthly societies and transplanting them into space. It's very clear that he has a background in medieval studies, and this book could probably be subtitled "A Rather Negative View of Medieval History in Space." Psychohistory, while ridiculous, is a fun concept in the abstract. And it would not surprise me - if I knew more about the history of sci-fi - if I were able to make some claims about the importance of this work for the genre.

Despite that, it can be a bit of a slog to read. This is in large part do to a lack of variation in structure. The book is essentially set up as four short stories covering a hundred-odd years of space history and each story follows the same trajectory: a Great Man uses his wits to outsmart all the dummies around him. This is fun the first time it happens, and I quite like the Salvor Hardin story. But all the stories are essentially variations on that, with the characters and details switched out. It feels almost like reading a detective story, where you know the protagonist is going to have an "Ah-ha!" speech at the end of each section as all of his political rivals slink away in crushing defeat.

The themes are also a bit tired, or lacking in nuance. It's a pessimistic book in a lot of ways, with

the premise riding on the assumption that the vast majority of people are dumb and unimaginative, and that religion and commerce are best seen as tool of mass manipulation. These are not inherently bad subjects to tackle, but to tackle them with subtlety requires a solid and varied characterization that Asimov doesn't really possess.

Not a terrible book by any means, and worth a read if you're interested in sci-fi in general. But be prepared for some eye-rolling as you go along.

The investigation of science, religion and trade, and how they can work together and against one another is remarkably well done. It was unusual to read Asimov sans robots, but of course he didn't disappoint. Highly recommended to anyone and everyone!

The introduction tells the story of how Isaac Asimov came up with the idea for this series (the fall of the Roman Empire in space basically) and how the original publication proceeded. The interesting part came when he'd completed the trilogy and was very much done with the Foundation novels, but could not escape their popularity and was eventually strongly persuaded by his publishing company to write more Foundation novels. When he re-read his trilogy, he found that he did have a lot of unanswered questions and there was a lot more to write, and so he wrote the sequels and prequels. I'll be reading this series in publishing order.
