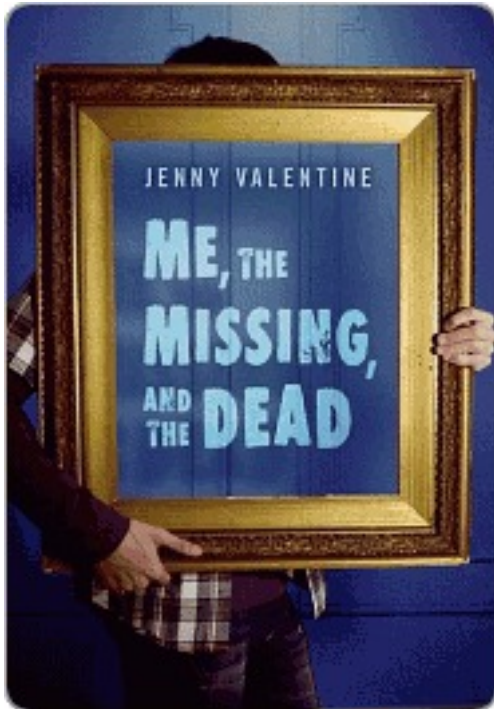

Angelina Justice: This novel gets four stars for many reasons, but at the top of the list is that it is a short novel. This makes it an easier sell to reluctant readers, especially guys. Guys are my second top reason for giving four stars. This book is written from a "guy" perspective in a voice that resonates with how boys/men think and communicate.

Women, and maybe even many men, often forget that the "real" male and the fictional male are often worlds apart. Novels abound with stereotypes of men both positive and negative. It is a rare novel that captures the essence of male thinking and being. Male characters are often two dimensional in comparison to their female counterparts in a story.

Steph Bowe: Finding Violet Park is a funny and original novel. It tells the story of Lucas Swain, our peculiar narrator, and how he comes to know Violet Park – a woman who has been dead for five years, who he finds in an urn in a taxi office. The Swain family have their own problems – Lucas' father has been missing for years, and Lucas' mother can't deal with it anymore. Over the course of the novel, Lucas gets to know his grandparents better, deceives a Tony Soprano look-a-like in order to steal the ashes of someone he's never met, gets a girlfriend called Martha and befriends a dead woman.

Somehow, by stumbling across an urn, he'll discover his family's secrets and what really happened to his father, as well as becoming his own person, not a copy of his father.

The premise is unique and the writer's style is enchanting. I loved the way in which everything tied in together, but the story remained believable. Lucas is a hilarious hero with a great voice. Jenny Valentine is a fantastic author, and Finding Violet Park is an immensely readable novel.

Stephanie: Lucas met Violet after she died. But it didn't stop him from getting to know her. He found her in an urn at the taxi office one night when he was too tired to walk home. The story is at once a meditation [on death and dying](#), and a mystery of piecing together the clues of who Violet is, who Lucas is, and ultimately, who his father is.

I loved this book. It's a quick read. The mystery moves the story forward and the observations about the fallibility of parents and family bonds give it depth.
