Kate Schwarz: This Baseball Card Adventure series is just fantastic. The more I think about them and the more in the series that I read, the more I like them. They are interesting stories with true, interesting male ball players (that is a downside, but more of that in a minute) set in America with a fictional twist that makes all the facts more inviting. The age range is 8 to 12 but Ben, nearly 6, has been enjoying listening to me read them aloud to him for the past 6 months. The books are so great that his sister Lorelei has begun to read with us and read by herself the ones Ben and I read earlier in the summer when she thought that baseball books weren't her thing. So even though these are "heavily boy" books, they are not--they tell human tales, and shouldn't boys and girls both know about this kind of stuff?

Shoeless Joe is a character special to us because my Grandpa K played baseball against and with him when my Grandpa played in the minor leagues in Erie, PA. (He could have gone to the majors but enlisted when WWII broke out instead, then returned to marry his sweetheart and took a more "honest" job than baseball to support her and their family. But that's another story.) I've grown up hearing his name thrown about but it wasn't until I had a baseball-crazy son of my own that I got interested in learning the history of the sport.

In the book, Stosh goes back in time to try and undo the Black Sox Scandal, of which Shoeless Joe was a part (or was he?! more on that later too). Stosh gets in a few dangerous situations but he risks life and limb to save one of his heroes, Joe. Talking to Ben about the scandal--he knew about it but this book went into more details--was just fantastic. Why would someone want to throw a game? How does gambling work? Why would these guys bully Joe into participating in the fix? These questions and the conversations make me love being a parent. Talking about all this bad stuff in the safety of a lap or bedroom or whatever safe spot you read with your kids in, helps prepare them for the reality of life, I think.

Anyway, the big lesson in this book is that life isn't fair. I say that to my trio all the time--they know it's true because with three kids there is a lot of unfairness going on most days in our house. But Gutman uses my words exactly "It all evens out in the long run." I loved that my kids were getting that message from someone other than me. The unfair lesson is, not to spoil the punchline, that Joe and 7 other players were banded from professional baseball because they were part of the scandal. Despite the fact that Joe never met with any of the swindlers. Despite the fact that he refused the money and to participate twice. Despite the fact that he never was in any meetings with the players who participated in the fix. Despite the fact that he asked to be benched. Despite the fact that he had a fantastic World Series that year--better than anyone else. It was a good lesson.
