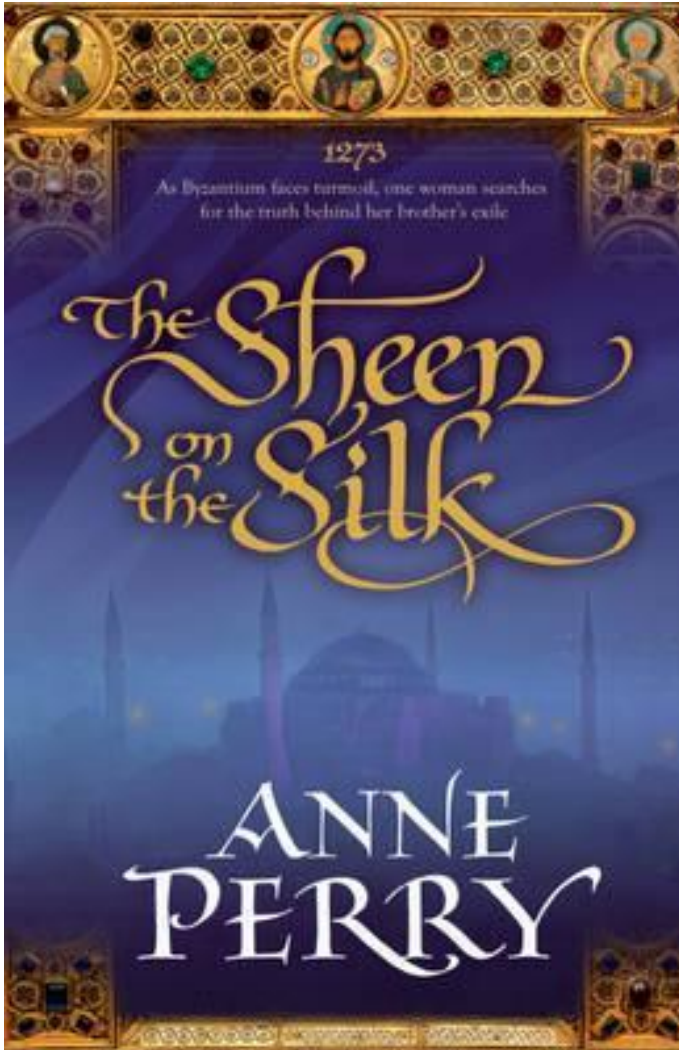

Faced with the prospect of surrendering its gentile Orthodox theology to Roman Catholicism, the city is in turmoil as opposing factions seek to assert their authority.

For Anna, the brutal conflict only echoes her own life. Recently arrived in Byzantium to find out why her brother has been exiled for a murder she believes he did not commit, Anna is forced to pose as a eunuch so that she can move freely in all levels of society. As she does so she finds herself in the middle of intrigues that may not only free, or condemn, her brother, but will also determine the fate of Byzantium itself.

Insightful reviews

Jack Murphy: I was torn between giving Ann's book a 3 or 4 stars. I listened to this audio book by Ann Perry during my trips to work. Ann Perry has certainly done her homework, researching the history of Constantinople. The historical part of this book is fantastic. I felt really immersed in Byzantium as I read it. The story itself is slow but interesting. The main character, Anna, is a foreigner masquerading as a eunuch doctor in order to investigate the cause of her brother's exile and imprisonment. However, her investigation takes a number of years (slow story, as I said). The most interesting character is Zoe Crysaphes, a 70-plus year old matron of wealth and power who is driven by vengeance. She presents first as an antagonist and villain, then gradually grows into her grudging respect and admiration for Anna. I think she is one of the most interesting characters in the book. The main conflict is the status of Byzantium itself -- barely recovering from being sacked by Crusaders 70 years before and still struggling to maintain its independence from the Roman Catholic Church. Will it survive another Crusade? I'm a romantic at heart and loved the underlying love story between Anna and Julio Dundaldo, the nephew of the Doge of the Venetian City state.

Eric Wright: Perry's *Sheen on the Silk* showcases a rich cast of characters living during a turbulent period in history, circa 1273. The main setting of the book is Constantinople but Venice, Rome, Palestine and Sicily also form part of the rich tapestry of this historical novel.

Anna Zarides arrives in the Byzantine capital in 1273 to prove the innocence of her twin brother. In order to move freely in society and discover the plot that resulted in her brother's banishment to a monastery in the Sinai, Anna disguises herself as a eunuch. Coming from a family of

doctores she slowly distinguishes herself among the city's elite.

She crosses paths with Zoe Chrysaphes, a scheming noblewoman, Giuliano Dandolo, sent to spy on the city, and a wide range of important characters. Sometimes it is hard to identify some of them.

Intrigue fills the pages during a period 70 years after the sack of Constantinople by a crusading army when another crusade is being organized. The city fear annihilation at the hands of an alliance of French, Venicians, and Romans. Popes come and go but the lust for the riches of Byzantium trumps all--even the desire to conquer the holy land.

While she ushered me into a period and place concerning which I had little knowledge, and for that I am thankful, I found the story line to be thin. We were as often in the head of Zoe, or the emperor, or Giuliano, as Anna, the main character.

Mickey Boggs: I've read most, if not all, of Anne Perry's previous works and especially enjoy the two series featuring Thomas Pitt and William Monk. When I read the flyleaf description of this book I wasn't sure it was something up my alley. But I found myself totally captivated by this book. Having been to Istanbul, Venice and Messina (albeit 700+ years later) and having seen the Hagia Sophia, the canals and harbors her vivid imagery just made the whole book "pop" for me. The description of daily life in the late 13th century, especially the practice of medicine and the "three" genders, was fascinating. Even the struggles between the Roman & Orthodox churches came alive for me. Fascinating characters all the way around and I love how she's mixed fact & fiction with real-life emperors, popes, doges and kings alongside characters of her own creation.

I highly recommend this book and if you still have doubts, check out the video on her website where she gives a wonderful 10-minute overview with relatively few spoilers!

Joanne Dowd: I struggled to complete this book. the final premise is interesting, the historic aspect is fascinating, however the tale is thin. it could possibly have, and sure must have been edited down by means of a pair hundred pages. i'm an important Anne Perry fan and was once excited to work out fresh characters from her. Anna is a physician who involves Constantinople disguised as a eunuch to find what occurred to her brother. The "villainess" Zoe - what a two-legged plot machine she was! Doing no matter what she wanted, poisoning humans via the dozen, leaving her enemies useless at any time when their servants became their backs, and never even as soon as she was once suspected of anything, no, each person (including the heroine) enjoyed her and cried after her while she died.
