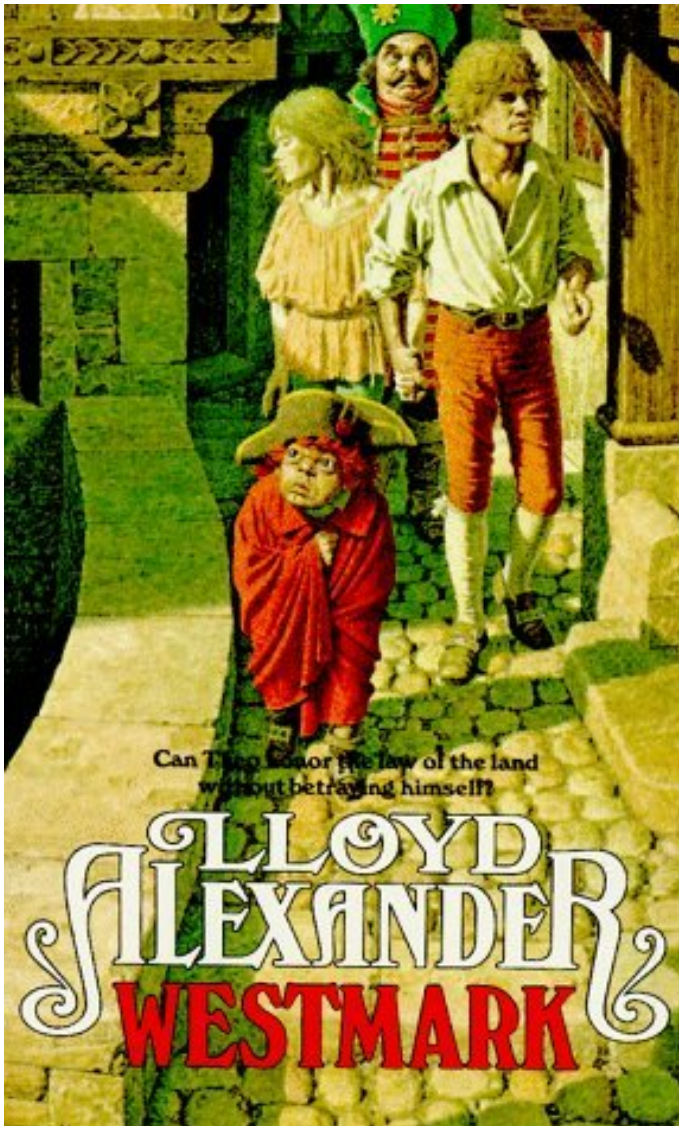

Sara: Lloyd Alexander remains one of my enduring beloved authors. Having read and loved the Prydain Chronicles as an elementary-school student (and to this day, frankly), I discovered his Westmark Trilogy in (I think) either late middle school or early high school, and was utterly enchanted. It was also a revelation to me: fantasy didn't have to be medieval!!! It didn't even have to have nonhuman characters or any magical trappings at all. Sharing the adventures of Theo and friends in the pseudo-18th century setting of Westmark is still something I revisit every other year or so, and they've never lost their delight for me. That being said, however, the Westmark trilogy (particularly after this first book), definitely qualifies as one of Lloyd Alexander's 'darker' writings. (Mind you, what passes for dark for Mr. Alexander still isn't hugely dark, and that's quite all right.) There is murder, and betrayal, and--as Theo learns--black-and-white morality is a difficult and extremely rare beast. But there is also love and friendship and learning that some things are worth fighting and dying for.

As is to be expected from an Alexander book, the cast of characters is colorful, the villain is appropriately horrible (really horrible, in fact), and (as is common with Alexander heroes) Theo--the-protagonist spends a great deal of time charmingly bewildered and outright frustrated. He has a harder time of it than, say, Taran of Caer Dalben. Although the two characters share a certain commonality--both do their growing up in a country torn by war--Theo is a young man of very black-and-white morality and a certain rigid honesty who is very much an everyman: what he'd really like is to be left alone to do an honest job for an honest wage. Instead, his master, who runs a printing press, is murdered by government soldiers and Theo--having struck out at one of the men--finds himself on the run for (he believes) murder. In order to survive, he finds

himself taking up with thieves and conmen and discovers--to his horror--that he has a certain flair for con-artistry. Unwilling to give up his views of the world as black and white, he runs away a second time (despite falling in love with the street urchin Mickle) and tries once again to make what he considers an honest living as a letter-writer (being able to read and write well, he offers his services to those who cannot), and before long ends up to his eyeballs in revolutionaries. He agrees with their cause--enough to actually join them--but struggles with the dubious morality many of them embrace in regards to things he finds distasteful. Eventually, he is reunited with Mickle, who is not quite what she seems, and rather than finding his life settled into a neat, orderly compartment as he dearly wished Theo finds himself in an even bigger tangle, thus setting things up for the next two books.

Wendy: A smart, fast-paced YA fantasy. Two things really impress me about this book. First, the sheer economy of language with which Alexander makes a large cast of characters vivid and keeps the plot moving. This book accomplishes more in ~185 pages than many a doorstopper fantasy accomplishes in twice the space. (Which is good, because once I started it, I didn't really want to put it down.)

Second, Alexander does a great job of making his characters have different goals and points of view. Being a good guy in this book is a complicated thing - it doesn't mean that you want the same thing as all the other good guys.

Finally, anyone who's ever criticized fantasy for being generally politically retrograde will be pleased to hear that while some characters are out to restore the rightful monarch to the throne, some are much more interested in seeing the people of Westmark rule. (Personally, I've been wishing for ages for more fantasy novels in which the characters fight to restore the just and rightful democracy, and Lloyd Alexander's had one for a couple of decades now.)

Kaye: i've got regularly enjoyed Lloyd Alexander's Chronicles of Prydain series, so i used to be wanting to learn this trilogy and go back to his liked sort of writing. the following there's either freshness and familiarity for Alexander fans, and a very good learn into the bargain!Familiarity? i believe it mostly comes from the characters of Westmark, who endure awesome resemblance to the characters that inhabit Prydain. the fancy and exaggerating Ffleuddur Fflam from the Chronicles of Prydain may nearly double as count number Las Bombas during this book, and Taran wouldn't leave out a beat within the function of Theo. Mickle is Eilonwy, minus the latter's feisty sarcasm and her prominence within the story. The gallant Florian jogs my memory of Gwydion (but i've got a sneaking suspicion that he'll meet a sad destiny afterward within the trilogy...) Lloyd Alexander definitely has a favourite solid of characters who – although their names may possibly change among books – stay at center endearing and recognizable. Freshness? Alexander's writing is usually clean and fluid. His protagonists are thoughtful, and questions are raised that experience no effortless answer. because the Westmark trilogy is aimed toward a touch older viewers than the Prydain Chronicles, those matters are handled much more deeply. In a global of injustice, harsh realities, and survival, what does it suggest to have honor, stay truthfully, and feature courage? sincere and affirming, clean and familiar, i'm definitely looking ahead to carrying on with Lloyd Alexander's Westmark trilogy.
